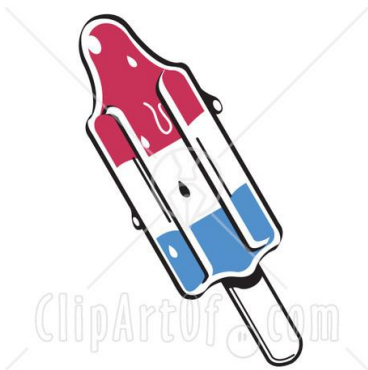

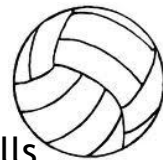
DODGEBALL MANIA

Tuesday, July 20th



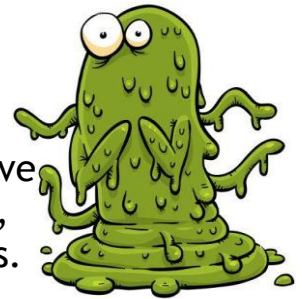
GUYS VS GALS

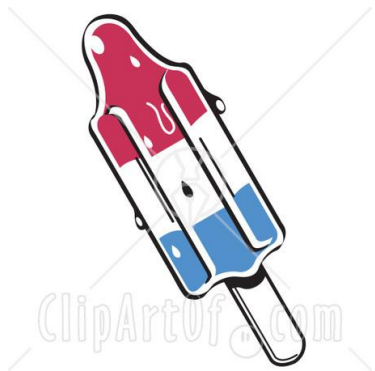
