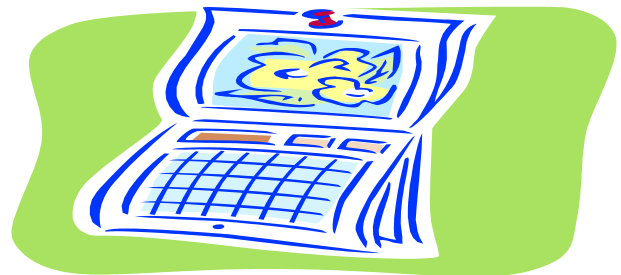
## Argyle Township Court House 2008 calendars

- Placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd at a Regional (outside NS), National or International sanctioned Championship.

### INDIVIDUALS

- Top 3 provincial placing in any sport.
- A Yarmouth County athlete on a provincial championship team representing an area of the province outside of Yarmouth County.
- Team representative that goes to Regionals (outside NS), Nationals or Internationals.
- Individual from outside Yarmouth County on a Yarmouth team that won Provincials and/or went on to Regionals and/or Nationals.
- Team that won Atlantics and/or participated in Nationals.
- Finished in the top 3 on a University/College individual sport at Provincials or Atlantics or participated at Nationals.

### OTHER

- Athlete, coach, and or volunteer may be recognized as outstanding at Provincial or National level.

For the purposes of these criteria, championships **MUST** be sanctioned by a Provincial or National Sport Governing body and recognized as such by the Yarmouth Department of Leisure Services and the Argyle Municipal Recreation Department.
