

Campers will be playing birthday party games.



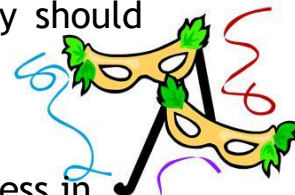


## Week 3- July 19<sup>th</sup> - July 23<sup>rd</sup> 2010

Friday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>

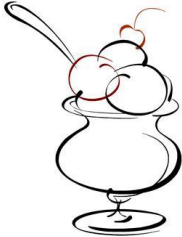
### **SANTA'S COMING TO TOWN**

### PYJAMARAMA

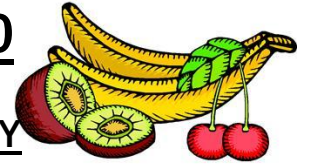
Today is a Pj and Bad hair

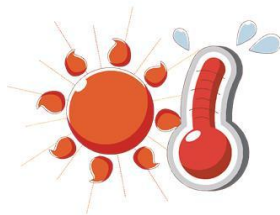


Wednesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>
