



BY-LAW #1

INTERPRETATION

1. This By-Law is entitled the “Interpretation By-Law”.
2. In this By-Law:
 - a. “existing or future by-law, policy, recorded resolution or resolution” means a by-law, policy, recorded resolution or resolution of the Municipality of the District of Argyle in force immediately before the coming into force of this By-Law, or a by-law, by-law amendment, policy, policy amendment or resolution of the Municipality of the District of Argyle which comes into force after the coming into force of this By-Law.
3. In the By-Law and in any existing or future by-law, policy, recorded resolution or resolution, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - a. Words importing the singular number only include the plural number and vice versa;
 - b. words importing only one gender include the masculine, feminine and neutral genders;
 - c. all references to officers or employees of the Municipality of the District of Argyle include a person authorized or appointed in an interim or “acting” capacity;
 - d. all references to an employee of the Municipality of the District of Argyle include references to subordinate employees authorized to act in place of or on behalf of the employee;
 - e. all reference to committees are references to committees of the Municipality of the District of Argyle;
 - f. all reference to the time of day shall be to that system of time in use in the Municipality of the District of Argyle at the relevant time whether it be “Atlantic Standard Time” or “Atlantic Daylight Time”;

- g. words in any by-law, policy, recorded resolution or resolution have the meaning ascribed to them in definition in that by-law, policy, recorded resolution or resolution, and, if no definition is contained therein or if the context indicates otherwise,
 - i. they have the meaning ascribed to them in the section 4 of this By-Law, and, if no definition is contained herein or if the context indicates otherwise;
 - ii. they have the meaning ascribed to them in definitions in the legislation enabling that by-law, policy, recorded resolution or resolution, and, if no definition is contained therein or if the context indicates otherwise;
 - iii. they have the meaning ascribed to them in definitions in the *Interpretation Act*;
4. For purposes of section 3.7.a. of this By-Law, the following definitions apply unless the context otherwise requires:
- a. Municipality of Argyle means Municipality of the District of Argyle and municipal has a corresponding meaning;
 - b. “Building Inspector” means the Building Inspector of the Municipality of Argyle;
 - c. “By-Law” means by-law of the Municipality of Argyle;
 - d. “By-Law Enforcement Officer” means the employee(s) of the Municipality of Argyle appointed to enforce some or all of the by-laws of the Municipality of Argyle;
 - e. “Chief Administrative Officer” or “CAO” means the Chief Administrative Officer of the Municipality of Argyle;
 - f. “Council” means the Council of the Municipality of Argyle;
 - g. “Councillor” means a member of Council;
 - h. “Development Officer” means the Development Officer of the Municipality of Argyle;
 - i. “District” means a polling district of the Municipality of Argyle approved by the Utility and Review Board and, then followed by a number, indicates a particular district as identified in materials submitted to and approved by the Utility and Review Board when defining the Municipality of Argyle’s polling districts;

- j. "Warden" means the Warden of the Municipality of Argyle and Deputy Warden has a corresponding meaning;
- k. "Municipal Staff" means an employee of the Municipality of Argyle authorized by or through the CAO to undertake and activity;
- l. "Person" means any person, male or female, and any body corporate, and includes a partnership except when modified by the word "human" or "natural";
- m. "Province" means the Province of Nova Scotia and "provincial" has a corresponding meaning;
