

# **MUNICIPALITY OF THE DISTRICT OF ARGYLE**

## **BY-LAW #13**

### **TRADE AND LICENSING**

1. No person shall act as auctioneer of or peddle hawk or trade goods unless he holds a license therefore which is in force. This Section shall not apply to merchants with an established place of business within the Municipality.
2. No person shall take or solicit orders for photographs or enlargements of photographs made by any process, where there is to be a consideration moving to such person for making or delivering such photographs, unless he holds a license therefore which is in force.
3. No person shall, on his own behalf or as an agent of another, exercise within the Municipality the calling of a book agent or magazine salesman, or peddle, hawk, take orders for or otherwise deal in books or magazines without having first obtained a license therefor.
4.
  - a) No person shall engage in the business of transporting persona for compensation or operate a taxi-cab as owner thereof to transport persons for compensation, unless he holds a valid license in respect of such vehicles, issued to him under this By-Law, hereinafter referred to as a “Taxi License”
  - b) No person shall drive a taxi-cab owned by another to transport persona for compensation unless he has a valid license issued to him under this By-Law, hereinafter referred to as a “Driver’s License”.
5. Nothing in this By-Law shall affect:
  - a) A person offering to sell the products of the farm, the forest, or the sea, or
  - b) Any sheriff, bailiff or other officer of the law selling under legal process.

6. The Clerk shall issue licenses under this By-Law which shall expire December 31st of each year, upon payment of the following annual fees:

Where the applicant is not a resident or ratepayer in the Municipality:

1. Auctioneer	\$40.00
2. Hawker, trader, or peddler	\$40.00
3. Photographer, canvasser, solicitor or agent	\$40.00
4. Magazine salesman	\$40.00
5. Taxi License	\$10.00
6. Driver's License	\$2.00

7. a) No person shall conduct any circus, itinerant, amusement, bowling alley, night club, shooting gallery, outdoor theatre, merry-go-round, or novelty ride unless he holds a license from the Municipality for that purpose which is in force; provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed as preventing or restricting the licensing of such activity under the provisions of the Theatres and Amusement Act, Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1967, Chapter 304 and any regulations made thereunder.

b) The annual fee for such a license shall be Forty (\$40.00) Dollars and shall be payable on the first day of January in each year.

c) Every amusement or place of amusement licensed under this By-Law shall remain closed between the hours of one o'clock in the morning and nine o'clock in the same morning.

8. (a) In these By-Laws, "Arcade" means any premises which houses two (2) or more automatic machines;

"Automatic Machine" means any pin-ball or video game machines or any automatic or slot machine (so-called) which is operated by the introduction of a coin or counter but does not include automatic scales, telephone apparatus, or electric meters, nor those things the use or keeping thereof is prohibited by law.

(b) No person shall conduct or establish an "Arcade" unless he holds a license from the

Municipality for that purpose which is in force, provided that nothing herein shall be construed as preventing or restricting the licensing of such activity under the provisions of the Theatres and Amusement Act, R.S.N.S. 1967, Chapter 304 and any regulations made thereunder.

(c) The annual fee for the license for an Arcade shall be Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per automatic machines as allowed for in the license, and such annual fee shall be payable on the first day of January in each year.
