Temporary Borrowing Resolution – FCM Loan

Director of Finance, Marsha d'Eon explained that the existing Temporary Borrowing Resolution expired on October 13, 2021. This is for a capital loan for the new administration building.

It is moved by Guy Surette and seconded by Kathy Bourque for Council to approve the renewal of the temporary borrowing resolution for the Municipality of the District of Argyle.

Temporary Borrowing Resolution – Operating Reserve

Director of Finance, Marsha d'Eon explained that in January of 2021, Council approved and authorized the CAO to lend \$800,000 from the operating reserve to the capital reserve. There have been some delays with the FCM loan coming through. The funds are currently expected on January 5, 2022. The Director of Finance is recommending that Council allow and authorize the Director of Finance to lend an additional \$500,000 from the operating reserve to the capital reserve with interest at 2.45% and to be repaid to the operating reserve upon receipt of the FCM loan.

It is moved by Guy Surette and seconded by Richard Donaldson to authorize the Director of Finance to lend \$500,000 from the operating reserve to the capital reserve. Motion Carried (8 in favour, 0 against)

Letter of Support Request – Tusket Ford

Councillor Surette declared a conflict of interest

Warden Muise explained that an employee at Tusket Ford reached out to him stating they will be writing a letter to the RCMP concerning tow truck calls. Tusket Ford expressed that when the RCMP arrive on the scene of an accident, they call Tusket Ford's competitors more times than they call Tusket Ford. Tusket Ford's request to the RCMP is for them to call Tusket Ford when they need a tow truck in the Municipality of Argyle, if the people in the accident don't have a tow truck preference. The employee at Tusket Ford asked if Council could write a letter of support for them. Council discussed this in detail. They came to an agreement to not write a letter of support, as Tusket Ford is a private business, and they feel this is a matter to be settled between Tusket Ford and the RCMP.
