2020-21 capital budget presentation

Capital budget highlights

Total Federal Gas tax expenditures is expected to reach \$1,255,000, with \$550,000 applied to the administrative building project.

- Remaining investments include the third and final COMFIT solar project on the Wedgeport Fire Department (total investment of \$275,000), West Pubnico dewatering investment of \$285,000 and trail improvements of \$50,000 to address Active Transportation improvements.

Other capital investments will total \$3,803,000, with \$2,193,000 of that invested in the new administrative building.

- Remaining investments include \$1,040,000 for the Wedgeport Septic Tank Replacement project - fully funded by residents and Provincial/Federal Government.
- Contributions to Ferry Terminal Project and Eel Brook Fire Station (\$200,000 and \$100,000) which were expected last year but did not occur.
- Other investments in Hipson Bridge, Tusket Waste Water, fire ponds and completing the road construction in Tusket.

Administrative building

- ▶ A total of \$2,744,000 is expected to be spent in this fiscal year.
 - ▶ Final construction costs and borrowing and grants will be finalized in next fiscal year.
 - ▶ Depending on the cash flow timing, there could be short term cash flow issues in the capital reserve, which is why we are recommending bridge financing.
 - ▶ Financing would be as high as \$1,500,000, and would be secured locally, if required. Council has already passed a resolution to borrow up to \$3,014,000. This budget contemplates a short-term loan of \$1,500,000.

Cours JE Hatfield Court to be partially paved, and power brought to the back lot in Spring/Summer 2020.



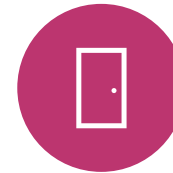
Signage for fire pond safety, and minor safety improvements - Spring for signage, fall for minor improvements.

Projected cash balances in capital funds

Capital Fund

Opening balance \$3,136,300

Closing balance \$2,518,100

Annual contributions from operations - \$135,000

The amount will be replenished when the full loan is received in June 2021.

However, payments on debt will come from this account.

Federal Gas Tax Fund

Opening balance \$1,520,045

Closing balance \$ 625,000

Annual federal contribution is approximately \$345,000.

Rural Broadband, recreation projects and wastewater projects are projected to be paid from here in future years.
