PROPOSED AMENDMENTS RE: LOBSTER STORAGE FACILITY AND PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT - DURAMAX HOLDINGS INC.

In accordance with Section 206 (1) of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Municipality of the District of Barrington intends to hold a Public Hearing to consider proposed amendments to the Municipal Land Use By-law and the approval of a Development Agreement as indicated below:

1. It is proposed that the Land Use By-law be amended to add the definition of a lobster storage facility and to identify approved zones and setbacks for these facilities.
2. Duramax Holdings Inc. has applied to establish a lounge in the Commercial General (CG) Zone, on their property located at 3412 Highway 3, in Barrington Passage, AAN 10260841, by Development Agreement, as per the Land Use By-law.

Proposed amendments and development agreement may be viewed by interested persons between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, excluding holidays, at the Office of the Chief Administrative Officer, in the Administrative Centre, Civic No. 2447, Highway 3, Barrington, NS.

Any representation by interested persons concerning these matters may be made at the Public Hearing of Council to be held in the Council Chambers, in the Administrative Centre, in Barrington, on Monday April 26, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. Due to gathering restrictions, please contact me should you wish to appear in person.
