NÊW PORTABLE ULTRASOUND!

Offering flexibility, speed, and accuracy, **portable ultrasound machines** are vital tools for providing physicians imaging and diagnostics. As smaller and more compact pieces of equipment, they are incredibly handy during the perioperative process. They allow the physician to scan, diagnose, and monitor a patient's condition right at their bedside!

These advanced ultrasounds will also allow anesthesiologists to administer surgical pain blocks, reduce pain during and after surgery, and assist anesthesiologists administering regional anesthesia. They provide vibrant images of the anatomy and surrounding nerves to optimize local anesthesia distribution. Put simply, they are an excellent addition for patient post-op pain control.

Patients can begin treatment sooner because they don't need to wait for conventional imaging modalities, potentially improving outcomes, as rapid diagnosis and treatment initiation are crucial in many conditions. It's all about delivering the right care at the right time and in the right place.



Keeping the Pantry Full

The work done by the Outpatient Community Mental Health & Addiction Program is vital for our community. Russell Robicheau (Manager of Southwest Outpatient Adult, Child & Adolescent Clinics) spoke with us to discuss some of the challenges in their work - and how the foundation was able to help.

As Russell explains, "Dr. Sara Bartel, one of our doctoral psychologists, works with folks with complex eating disorders. Sometimes, treatment involves eating a meal in front of her, and our patients are expected to bring in the food. But sometimes they just didn't really have money to afford that. People carry shame about being in a precarious financial situation, and it becomes impossible to provide effective mental health treatment. So, we received funding from the foundation to start our pantry program."

The Yarmouth Hospital Foundation was happy to help, all thanks to our generous donors. Two pantries were installed, enabling patients to access food when they need it. "If our patients are at an appointment, they can grab what they need. Then they're able to focus on what needs to be done."

But even a pantry has its limits. Russell tells us more. "We also received funding from the foundation to provide grocery gift cards for patients who are unable to afford the food needed as part of their treatment that happens at home. It's been a huge benefit."

Russell is proud of the work done in his department. "I want people who really need mental health assessment and treatment to be able to access it and not have their financial situation hinder them. And the foundation has been instrumental, we wouldn't be able to do it without them."
