Municipality of Argyle Provides Assistance to Residents Impacted by Drought

Tusket, NS - The Municipality of Argyle recognizes the ongoing challenges residents are facing due to drought conditions and is taking steps to support the community. To assist residents, the municipality is offering the following services:

NON-POTABLE WATER DELIVERY: The municipality is offering to deliver non-potable water to residents with water shortages at no cost, through the Department of Operational Services. The water is meant to be delivered into water storage containers, and not directly in wells.

The water shall be used for non-potable purposes, including but not limited to flushing toilets, dish or other basic washing (with soap). Water may also be boiled for cooking uses or more sterilized cleaning.

PROCESS: Residents shall pre-register their request for non-potable water, confirming their availability to accept such shipment. Upon request, the shipments shall be delivered to a water storage container as the schedule permits, between Monday to Friday. Availability of the shipment is dependant upon staff availability.

DRINKING WATER COUPONS: The Municipality will be providing drinking water coupons to residents experiencing dry wells. These coupons can be exchanged for drinking and cooking water at select retail locations. Each household can receive 4L of bottled water per person per day, with a maximum of four 4L jugs per household per day. Coupons are valid until November 30, 2025.

PROCESS: Coupons can be picked up at the office, located at 5 J.E. Hatfield Court in Tusket, Monday to Friday 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Please call (902) 648-2316 for more information on how to register.
